How to connect to Access DB



To connect an MS Access database to your project, please follow the instructions below:

1 - Click on the Connect to database button.




2 - Select the **Direct Access File Driver** option.






3 - Browse for the database file and click on Next.



Note: We strongly recommend that you connect your Access file with the *.mdb format.




4 - All tables from the connected database should be displayed afterwards. Choose the one you want to work with and click on **Next**.






5 - You must now select all the columns that you want to load on this database connection and click on **Next**.






6 - If you have a Primary Key field in your table, it should automatically be selected, so click on **Next** then.



7 - The Database Filter step should be ignored, so click on **Next** again.



8 - Finally, select the column(s) that will define the order of your database table. As you click on **Finish**, the database will be connected to the project.





As the **Database** tab appears on the right side of the software interface, it means that the connection to the database was successful.

This view allows the user to quickly drag-and-drop any database information to the layout design.
